

Kindergarten

The Kindergarten program at Learning Brooke offers a positive balance between social, emotional, cognitive and physical development. Children are encouraged to be active participants as they question, theorize and study themselves, their community and the world we live in. Long term investigations and projects inspire children to provide narrative and structure to the learning experience. Our teachers use observation, dialogue and documentation with children to develop and deepen the curriculum, while encouraging the children to explore and test new ideas. The children's theories are then expressed through different languages, both oral and written, clay, paint, dance, wood, wire and music, to name a few. In a naturally integrated and child directed way, children will acquire reading, writing, mathematical, scientific and social skills. This experience will help them achieve ownership of their learning and motivate them to question, analyze and theorize as their educational careers continue.

Objectives

- provide an enriched environment with many opportunities for social, emotional, physical, language and cognitive development
- foster active engagement with natural materials in the social world around us
- promote creativity and provide a range of opportunities to express feelings and ideas, with the focus on the process rather than the product
- instill collaboration, leadership and teamwork concepts
- incorporate families in the learning process within the classroom, and help
- develop a sense of community
- widen their experiences through use of critical thinking skills and problem solving
- empower children to succeed in school and in life

Kindergarten Enrichment
